<b>Course objective</b> To provide knowledge and practical skills in understanding English texts in the field of biotechnology.			
<b>Learning outcomes</b> The students acquire competences in language structure and lexis (grammar competence and vocabulary). Students are able to understand and analyze the English text in field of biotechnology. Other important outcomes include students' capability of writing summaries of an English text, ability to cite references found on the Internet, to find and present orally the key ideas from the text.			
<b>Course contents</b> <i>Theoretical instruction</i> Grammar (gender of nouns, plural of nouns, pronouns, adverbs, prepositions, numerals, tenses, passive form); morphological processes - derivation; lexical analysis and terminology in English in the field of biotechnology; the analysis of English texts in the field of biotechnology; syntactic and semantic analysis; writing summaries; oral presentation of the key ideas in the text; The texts: 1. Plants 2. Life cycle of a plant 3. Plant growth and soil conditions 4. Photosynthesis; Transpiration 5. Applied chemistry: elements, atoms and molecules 6. Structure of an atom; Ion formation 7. Solutions; Miscible liquids; Emulsions and colloidal solutions 8. Hard water 9. Water pollution 10. Environment
